**Special City Council Meeting Held Via-Teleconference**

The Long Prairie City Council met by phone at City Hall, 7:00 pm, on Wednesday March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, Mayor Dixon called the meeting to order with the following present by phone or at City Hall: Council members, Bob Klick, Lilah Gripne, David Wright, Datrik Mitchell, and City Administrator Ted Gray. (New Business)

The city council was to hear the financial presentation on the CSAH 56 and CSAH 38 Road Projects and review resolutions relating to the assessment hearings for the project areas. Administrator Gray stated that in working with our financial team, Ehlers, Bolton & Menk and myself, we are unable to make the financial presentation tonight as we had scheduled. We are still working through the financial details to determine if the project will be eligible to receive PFA funding and grant opportunity. Without this information it is not possible to present an accurate financial picture of this project to the council and the residents present. Tentatively we will have the required information by our scheduled council meeting on March 14th. I would ask the council not to make a decision at this time on the proposed resolutions regarding the assessment hearing and move to the adjourn the meeting if there are no questions from council.

There was brief discussion on the next steps and timelines for the financial presentation.

**Council member Klick motioned Mitchell seconded to postpone the proposed resolutions regarding the assessment hearing until a later meeting. Motion carried unanimously.**
