Special City Council Meeting Held Via-Teleconference

The Long Prairie City Council met by phone at City Hall, 6:00 pm, on Wednesday April 27th, 2022, Mayor Dixon called the meeting to order with the following present by phone or at City Hall: Council members, Bob Klick, Lilah Gripne, David Wright, and City Administrator Ted Gray. Council member Datrik Mitchell was absent. Others present were Officer Trevor Larson, Officer Ryan Hanson, Officer Doug Rakow, and Office Ethan Wise

Council member Gripne motioned Klick seconded to approve the agenda for the special meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

(New Business)

The city council reviewed the presented schedule for the Long Prairie Police Department. The schedule had been revised due to the upcoming retirement of Chief Duane Breiter. The schedule would change the shifts for the police officers to a 12-hour rotation. This would continue to provide 24-hour coverage by the Long Prairie Police Department. The council had no concerns with the change in schedule. There will be an update on the schedule provided at the May 16th council meeting.

Administrator Gray presented to the council the hiring process for the Long Prairie Police Chief. The council was to review the applications provided and make a list of the applicants to be interviewed. These lists would be due back to the city administrator by the May 2nd council meeting.
