- -The Downtown Buildings Hometown Furniture and the Opera House were toured by an architect from Widseth out of Alexandria. The Hometown estimate for architectural plans was 2, 950; the Opera House was 3,500. Hometown has asked for a second estimate.
- -The estimate for the Hart Building brick work on the Facade was 295,000. The Targeted Communities Grant would fit half the bill if we applied for this grant and received it, however, there are many details that are impossible to get done by January 6, 2022. We will probably apply next year and use the services of a retired Initiative Foundation grant writer. Contact is being made soon. Jeremy Weber is not convinced about the estimate and brick work. He believes that there should not be any brick put on the fasade. Lu B told him that he would need to get an estimate from someone else soon in order to move forward.
