

Full Time Police Officer for the City of Long Prairie

The Long Prairie Police Department is taking applications for a Full Time Officer.

Graduates to Lateral transfers are encouraged to apply. The Long Prairie Police Department has a very successful relationship with the City Council, City Administration, and other agencies. We welcome all applicants and are well equipped to provide training for new and experienced officers.

General Duties:

The Police Officer is responsible for the preservation of law and order, the protection of life and property, the prevention and detection of crime, the provision of emergency services and the enforcement of laws and ordinances. Provides primary police protection by active patrol of the City.

Minimum Requirements:

Associate's degree (A. A.) in criminal justice. MN POST eligible or licensed.

Benefits:

The Long Prairie Police Department has a seven-step wage scale of \$29.77 to \$37.23, with yearly cost of living increases. With experience, officers may be placed in the appropriate step. Costs of individual health insurance is paid entirely; Family Coverage is supplemented by the City.
