1. The May 2026 meeting of the LPEDA was called to order by Lu in absence of Terri Jo.
2. The Pledge was omitted for this meeting.
3. Roll Call was taken with the following present: Terri Jo (remotely), Mary and Lilah. Lu and Leah were also in attendance. Dallas and Kevin were absent.
4. The review and approval of the April 2026 meeting will be approved at the July meeting.
5. The account balance is \$34,214. 98
6. In Old Business, Leah shared an update from the TCDC meeting on the Childcare facility.

There is an option for county to own or TCDC to own and manage. Neither like the proposed location of forfeited properties so need to look for another site. Mary mentioned that CentraCare lot southwest of CentraCare Drive might be a possibility. Also the former Zion United Church could be possible. We are in need of members for the board so Lu asked us to think about this. There is a meeting on May 28 at City Hall to determine use of the 1.2 million from Central Bi.
7. In New Business there was a visit on May 14 to Camphill Village, a joint effort of Sauk Centre and LP Chamber. There were about 50 people in attendance, 10 from LP. There was discussion of how to attract businesses to fill spots in the Industrial Park.
